Elements of a Good Presentation:

Line

Capture attention of audience in the very beginning

Think of your "hook" as your 30-second elevator pitch

Hook

#### Problem

- What are you trying to solve?
- · What is your main goal?
- · Why should they care?

#### Solution

- What is your solution?
- · How did you get there?
- · Why is this solution the best?

#### Plan

- What is your plan to implement the solution?
- What do you need from them to make it happen? How will you help?

#### Action

- What are the next steps that need to be taken?
- · How will you follow-up to show results?



## Sinker

If you're successful, what will that mean for everyone?

Think of your "sinker" as your last chance to persuade/wow your audience.





